

RESOLUTION 2015-1

TO APPROVE THE FORMATION OF A LAKE DISTRICT WITHIN THE TOWN OF PRAIRIE LAKE

WHEREAS the Town Board of Prairie Lake after consideration of the straw poll conducted in December, 2014, of the Town of Prairie Lake property owners within the proposed Lake District and other evidence submitted to it by the Chetek Lake Protection Association, has found the following:

1. The water quality of Prairie Lake and other lakes within the chain-of-lakes is deteriorating.
2. The proposed district expands the possibilities of improving the clarity and the quality of the water found in Prairie Lake as well as in the remainder of the Chain of Lakes.
3. The public health, comfort, convenience, necessity, or public welfare will be promoted by the establishment of the district.
4. The real property in the district will benefit from the establishment of the district.
5. The straw poll results demonstrate that 64.6% (172 of 265 respondents by January 1, 2015) of Town of Prairie Lake property owners within the proposed boundaries of the Lake District support the establishment of a Lake District.

AND WHEREAS the authority for action in this matter is found in §33.25(1)(a), Wis. Stats., A ...town board may by resolution represent persons owning lands within the proposed district who are within its jurisdiction, and sign for all such landowners.


AND WHEREAS the Town Board of the Town of Prairie Lake, Barron County, Wisconsin, by this resolution, adopted by a majority of the town board on a roll call vote with a quorum present does hereby support the Chetek Lakes Protection Association plans to establish a Lake District and does thereby support its enactment in accordance with Chapter 33, Wisconsin State Statutes.

THEREFORE BE IT NOW RESOLVED that, pursuant to §33.25, Wis. Stats., the Town Board hereby petitions the Barron County Board of Supervisors to establish a public inland lake protection and rehabilitation district, and directs the Chair of the Town of Prairie Lake to sign an appropriate petition for all property owners within the proposed Town of Prairie Lake boundaries for a Lake District.


In accordance thereof we this day set our hands to sign this resolution and make it a part of the permanent record thereof.
