

Resolution 2015 - 4
For maintenance of town road right-of-way

Whereas, Chapter 82.0 "Town Highways" and Chapter 86.0 "Miscellaneous Highway Provisions" of Wisconsin State Statutes grant authority to Towns for the care and supervision of all highways under the towns' jurisdiction;

And Whereas, although most road right-of-ways are defined as 66 feet in width there is great variation in the actual widths of road right-of-ways under the town's jurisdiction;

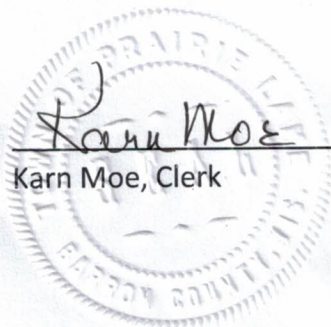
And Whereas, the Town of Prairie Lake intends to maintain the road right-of-ways to improve public safety, increase visibility and stabilize road shoulders while considering the needs of wildlife and native tree health by removing encroachments such as certain types of vegetation whether by cultivation or other means, fences or any other foreign objects placed in ditches without prior approval from the Town of Prairie Lake, and by prohibiting grading or other disturbances of shoulders and ditches without the express approval of the Town of Prairie Lake;

THEREFORE BE IT NOW RESOLVED by the Town Board of the Town of Prairie Lake that in order to further these ends:

1. Mowing will begin on or about June 15th
2. Two passes should be done by the 1st week of July
3. Two repeat passes should be done by Labor Day
4. Additional passes will be done as needed, where needed
5. Boom mowing will be done after first frost where needed.

In accordance thereof we this day set our hands to sign this resolution and make it a part of the permanent record thereof.
