

**AUTHORIZE SHIFTS FOR ELECTION INSPECTORS – ORDINANCE 2010-1
TOWN OF PRAIRIE LAKE**

The Town Board of the Town of Prairie Lake, does hereby ordain as follows:

Section 1: Ordinance 2010 - 1 is hereby created to read as follows:

- (1) **Authorization**: Wisconsin State Statute 7.30 (1) authorizes the appointment of election officials.
- (2) **Purpose**. To provide for the general welfare of the election workers by creating split shift for election workers who are required to work thirteen hours due to the mandates of the polls being open from 7:00 a.m. until 8:00 p.m.
- (3) **General Provisions**. The Town of Prairie Lake hereby adopts the powers set forth in Wisconsin Statute 7.30(1)(a), whereby a municipal governing body may provide by ordinance for the selection of alternate officials or the selection of two or more sets of officials to work at different times on election day, and may permit the municipal clerk to establish different working hours for different officials assigned to the same polling place.

Section 2: The creation of this ordinance shall be effective upon passage and posting as provided by Law.

This ordinance was adopted at a regular meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Prairie Lake on the 13th day of April, 2010, and shall be in force in perpetuity, or until revoked by a future action of this Board or any succeeding Board thereof.
