

RESOLUTION 2006-5

TO AUTHORIZE A 5-MEMBER PLAN COMMISSION FOR THE TOWN OF PRAIRIE LAKE

WHEREAS the TOWN OF PRAIRIE LAKE has heretofore been granted village powers – by Resolution 4 – 1962 on April 3rd, 1962, an act of the electors at the Annual Town Meeting;

AND WHEREAS the authority to create a Plan Commission for the Town was thereby granted;

AND WHEREAS the Town Board of the Town of Prairie Lake did create a Plan Commission to assist in the development of a comprehensive plan to guide the Board in decisions about land use and other matters as may be warranted by future events as set down in §§62.23(1)(2)(4)& (5) Wis Stats.;

AND WHEREAS the Comprehensive Plan is now completed and the duties pertaining therein are no longer required of the Plan Commission;

THEREFORE BE IT NOW RESOLVED that the Town Board of the Town of Prairie Lake does hereby approve a reduction in the number of Plan Commission members to five beginning with the 2007 term.

In accordance thereof we this day set our hands to sign this resolution and make it a part of the permanent record thereof.
